Jacques Grange designed the place, with emphasis on the natural light and high ceilings, and believe it or not, is supposed to be a downscale effort. Even though it looks swanky, The Mark features JGV's take on French comfort food (e.g., croque monsieur, even a burger!), though it's obviously a step (or five) up from your corner bistro.
